## Arkansas Scholars<sup>TM</sup> Student Incentive Ideas

- 1. Establish reward cards for discounts from local businesses. Some communities also offer "Hire Me First" cards to juniors and seniors on track for Arkansas Scholars.
- 2. Annually prepare a "Directory of Scholars" Distribute to employers and encourage them to refer to that list when considering a graduate for employment: "Is the applicant an Arkansas Scholar?" Have this list printed in the local newspaper if possible.
- 3. Release Arkansas Scholars students several minutes early to go to school assemblies. They'll get the best seats. Release them first from assemblies or similar events.
- 4. Reserve the best section of student parking for Arkansas Scholars students.
- 5. Give free or reduced admission to school sports and other events to Scholars candidates.
- 6. Use any give away on which you can print the Arkansas Scholars logo:
  - Tee shirts
  - Cups and koozies
  - CD carrying cases
  - Book covers and notebooks

- Refrigerator magnets
- Pencils or pens
- Key rings
- Bookmarks, mouse pads
- 7. Give passes to local events (movies, carnival, rodeo, festival, etc.)
- 8. Release for occasional off-campus lunch (suggested for juniors or seniors).
- 9. Hold annual or semester breakfasts, mid-morning brunch, or similar event for freshmen, sophomores, juniors, or seniors who are "on track" to be Arkansas Scholars.
- 10. Once or twice a year make goodie bags for Scholars with items from local businesses.
- 11. Give Scholars students recognition in local newspapers.
- 12. Give Scholars students recognition in the school year book.
- 13. Give Arkansas Scholars medallion or sash to wear at graduation ceremony.
- 14. Hold an awards banquet/luncheon/picnic/party/reception. If possible, video tape such events and show to your younger students. "It pays to be an Arkansas Scholar."
- 15. Invite someone of note (and with the right skills to speak to students) to speak to Scholars candidates. But, keep it brief!
